This is a basic outline if you wish to graduate with an Alberta High School Diploma and gain admission to a Canadian University for further study.

<b>Grade 12 Semester One</b>	<b>Grade 12 Semester Two</b>
Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2	English 30-1 or 30-2
Science at the 30 level (Biology, Chemistry, or Physics)	Science at the 30 level (Biology, Chemistry, or Physics) or option
Math 30-1 or 30-2	Math 30-1 or 30-2 (must be completed in semester 1 if wanting to take Math 31)
Science at the 30 level (Biology, Chemistry, or Physics)	Math 31 or option



***It is important to understand that all academic courses at the grade 12 level in Alberta require students to write a diploma examination (administered by the Government of Alberta) which contributes to 30% of the student's final mark for the course.***

It is understood that the timelines and course suggestions outlined above are based on documents received from the student and are an approximation. Student achievement is dependent on a number of factors, including effort and commitment on the student's part.
