***It is important to understand that all academic courses at the grade 12 level in Alberta require students to write a diploma examination (administered by the Government of Alberta) which contributes to 30% of the student's final mark for the course.***

Scheduled individual tutoring times will be held 1 – 2 times each week for one hour depending on your needs.

Study time is each evening for 1 – 2 hours.

It is understood that the timelines and course suggestions outlined above are based on documents received from the student and are an approximation. Student achievement is dependent on a number of factors, including effort and commitment on the student's part. The courses you will be enrolled in for each semester of school will be based, in part, on your achievement in the prior semester.
