DVSS has much to offer International students! Four levels of ESL classes are provided and used to determine appropriate program choices for students. Teachers provide tutorials and one on one assistance. Qualified tutors are available outside of school for an additional fee. Integration of International students with Canadian students is supported through the Ambassador program.
